### Tell Me the Story of Jesus By Robert Orren

As John the Baptist went about preparing the way of the Lord and preaching a message of repentance, he received a lot of attention. People were coming to him in droves to be baptized (Mark 1:4-6). John had a story to tell if he chose to do so. John was the cousin of the Messiah. He saw the Holy Spirit descend upon Jesus and remain there (John 1:33). Jesus Himself even said of John in Matthew 11:11, "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; ..."

It would have been easy for John to find some things about which to brag. But notice his words in John 3:30. "He must increase, but I must decrease." That should become our attitude more and more the longer we walk in the Light. As the song suggests, there should be less of self and more of Him until there is none of self and all of Him.

As a Christian, you indeed have a story to tell that will glorify God. But it is the story of Jesus!
