A few days ago while driving in another town, I saw a church sign that read, "When you tell your story, you give Him glory." I think I know what was trying to be said, but I can't help think it was said poorly. When bringing people to Christ, the focus should be on Him and what He has done.

As John the Baptist went about preparing the way of the Lord and preaching a message of repentance, he received a lot of attention. People were coming to him in droves to be baptized (Mark 1:4-6). But even with all the attention he was getting, he always pointed to the One who would come after him. In fact, John would point out how much greater Jesus was (Mark 1:7-8).

John had a story to tell if he chose to do so. John was the cousin of the Messiah. He saw the Holy Spirit descend upon Jesus and remain there (John 1:33). He was the one chosen to prepare the way for Jesus. Jesus Himself even said of John in Matthew 11:11, "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; ..."

It would have been easy for John to find some things about which to brag. But notice his words in John 3:30. "He must increase, but I must decrease." That should become our attitude more and more the longer we walk in the Light. As the song suggests, there should be less of self and more of Him until there is none of self and all of Him.

As a Christian, you indeed have a story to tell that will glorify God. But it is the story of Jesus!
