Why Do You Pray? **By Robert Orren**

When examining your prayer life, let me encourage you to look at the big picture. You could look at the small picture and ask "For what things do I pray?" The answer to that "small picture question" could be a number of things. In fact, the Bible tells us many things for which to pray. But when you look at the big picture, you can ask "Why do I pray?"

In Matthew 6:8, Jesus says "For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him." Why would you spend time in prayer to God if He already knows what you need anyway? I would suggest the answer is to improve your relationship with God.

Have you ever asked someone a question and they did not answer? Or have you tried to talk to someone who ignored you? One sided communication is not very efficient. In fact it is very frustrating. It is this way in our communication with God. God communicates to us through His word. We communicate back to God through prayer. If we do not take advantage of two-way communication with God, the relationship with Him is not all that it can be or all that He wants it to be.

You should pray at all times—even if you don't think you pray well. Paul said in Romans 8:26-27, "For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God."
