And since each of you has been in contact with numerous other people, your influence has branched off into different directions.

In John 1:35-42, we see several dominoes falling. John influenced more than one person. Andrew influenced more than one person. Peter influenced more than one person. But let's just work backwards from Peter. All of the people Peter brought to Christ were because Andrew first found him. And that was because of John the baptizer's influence on Andrew. And who knows? Perhaps the last domino from that chain has yet to fall. Maybe the last domino from your chain has yet to fall; but the first one must be set in motion. 
