I Learned it by Watching You By Robert Orren

Many of you may remember the Public Service Announcement from the mid-eighties where a father approaches his son about the boy's drug use. The father asks his son, "Who taught you how to do this stuff?" The boy yells, "You alright! I learned it by watching you."

Whether or not we realize it, we are teaching our children every day. Sometimes we teach with words and sometimes we teach by example. Sometimes we do both. God has given parents a huge responsibility to care for and provide for their children; but, the responsibility does not end there. Teaching them is a major part of that God-given responsibility as well.

In Psalm 78:1-6 we find a reference to three generations: the generation of "our fathers", which would be the previous generation; the generation of "their children", which would be the present generation; and the "generation to come", or the next generation. Then verses 7 and 8 say what is to be taught. "That they may set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments; And may not be like their fathers, A stubborn and rebellious generation, A generation that did not set its heart aright, And whose spirit was not faithful to God." We see in these verses the responsibilities to teach our children, and even our grandchildren, about God so that they will not forget what God has done and so they will also obey His commandments.

God had already commanded the Israelites to teach their children diligently (Deuteronomy 6:4-9). This concept is just as true today as it has ever been. The world can teach our kids so much that is harmful to their bodies and souls—in other words, what *it* wants for them. It is up to parents to teach their children about what *God* wants for them.
