Don't Let Relief Harden Your Heart By Robert Orren

I am sure you have heard some version of the following illustration. A man was patching a pitched roof of a tall building when he began sliding off. As he neared the edge of the roof he prayed, "Save me, Lord, and I'll go to church every Sunday, I'll give up drinking, I'll be the best man this city has ever known." As he finished his prayer, a nail snagged onto his overalls and saved him. The man looked up to the sky and shouted, "Never mind, God. I took care of it myself."

This may not be a true story in all its details, but it is early similar to the way many people respond to God's help. In fact, notice the similarities in this character and in Pharaoh in Exodus chapter 8.

In Exodus 8, God has brought about the second plague in Egypt—a plague of frogs. In verse 8, Pharaoh calls for Moses and Aaron to ask God to take away the frogs. Then Pharaoh will let the people go. In verses 12-13, we read that God caused the frogs to die and they were gathered up into big, stinking heaps.

Now we all know that Pharaoh hardened his heart and had to endure eight more plagues because of that hard heart. But it is interesting to read his reason in verse 15. "But when Pharaoh saw that there was relief, he hardened his heart and did not heed them, as the LORD had said," Exodus 8:15.

We like to think of Pharaoh as some extreme example of hard-heartedness. But his attitude is more common than you might think. It is common in times of trouble to cry out to God—to repent, to promise to change! But when the trouble is gone, the heart hardens again.

Let's be sure to keep our hearts soft during times of trouble and during those times that God brings relief.
